## Managing Occupational Health in the Workplaces

Studies and researches on occupational health reflect that the repercussions of occupational illnesses pose severe after-effect, threatening the daily life of the victims and increasing burden of the public health care system. However, the issues in relation to occupational health are very often disregarded by both the employer and employee as the instant effect of occupational health is insignificant.

The conference will be relevant to executives, professionals and managerial staff, particularly health and safety professionals and those with responsibility for health and safety at work.
