VISIT HIGHLIGHTS

Climate change and Electricity Saving are hot topics. The community must jointly practice the principles of "use less, waste less", including energy and water conservation, and green energy sources, with an aim of moving towards a low-carbon society.

In addition to the promotion of energy saving to tie in with the carbon reduction targets, the Government is actively exploring opportunities for harnessing renewable energy sources, for places such as sewerage treatment plants.

Hong Kong's Largest Solar Farm has been built in the Siu Ho Wan Sewage Treatment works, and was launched in December of 2016. The plant is equipped with over 4200 panels and generates 1.1 million kW hrs of electricity annually for the Siu Ho Wan Sewage Treatment works, which is about 25% of the current annual electricity consumption of the plant.
